Separate awards will be made for purebreds, derivatives and open at each level. Horses that have received 70% or more at a WAAHA event may not ride in the level below. Every effort will be made to avoid draw clashes with halter classes – judge will remain 30 mins after the final tests in the draw – it is the rider's responsibility to complete their tests before the 30 minutes has passed.

## **Rules and Conditions of Entry for the 2018 WAAHA All Arabian Show**

**It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor/Owner to abide by all rules set out here and in associated documentation.**

1.	<b>ASSOCIATION LIABILITY</b> - The Western Australian Arabian Horse Association Inc (WAAHA Inc) or any of its Agents, shall not be liable for any financial loss or damage, physical injury or property damage suffered by any person by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect however arising.
2.	<b>SHOW RULES</b> - This show is for Arabian and Arabian Derivatives and is governed by the current Arabian Horse Society of Australia Rule Book, EWA, and the SEC Rules and Regulations where no specific show rule is available. It is the responsibility of the entrant to read and be familiar with the rules. The current AHSA Rule book is available online at <a href="http://www.waaha.com.au">www.waaha.com.au</a> or <a href="http://www.ahsa.asn.au">www.ahsa.asn.au</a> . <b>** Competitors CANNOT be in contact with judges prior to competing.</b>
3.	<b>SEC RULES</b> - Any persons entering the stable area does so at their own risk and EWA and WAAHA Inc will not be held liable for any injury which may occur to riders, horses and general public. Under no circumstances may horses be tacked or tied up in the aisles. <b>Smoking is only permitted on the entrance road side of the main SEC pavilion – smoking will not be tolerated or accepted in any other area. No alcohol may be brought into the Centre. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER STABLES OR MARSHALLING AREA WITH PRAMS AND/OR SMALL CHILDREN. UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN ARE ALSO NOT PERMITTED IN THESE AREAS.</b>
4.	<b>MEMBER'S RATES</b> - Only current (2018) Junior, General, Family/Joint and Life members of the WAAHA Inc whose name appears on the Registration Certificate of an exhibit as the Owner or Lessee, are eligible to enter at WAAHA members rates. Membership fees must be paid before or on the close of entries. <b>Non-members of WAAHA (Inc.) competing in Rider/Handler classes MUST pay non-member rates for those classes regardless of the horse owners' membership status.</b>
5.	<b>ENTRIES</b> – <b>All entries must be made in the name of the registered owner/lessee of the exhibit.</b> Entries can be submitted online via <a href="http://nominate.com.au">nominate.com.au</a> , via post or via email and must be accompanied by the correct payment and all supporting documents. Refund of entries will not be made after the closing date of entries. A payment plan may be used, but full payment must be made by close of entries. <b>Incorrect and/or incomplete entries that have not been finalised by close of entries will incur an additional \$25 penalty fee.</b> <b>This may mean your entry is NOT listed in the catalogue.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• By lodging an entry the exhibitor shall be bound by the terms &amp; conditions set out herein. The signature of an entry form by an exhibitor shall be deemed to evidence acceptance of same.</li> <li>• Owners of ALL Purebreds and Derivatives must be <b>CURRENT FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF AHSA</b> to enter their horse(s) at this show.</li> <li>• Horses without a registration number cannot be exhibited.</li> <li>• All horses must be able to be identified by their brands and/or markings in accordance with the Certificate of Registration issued by the Society.</li> <li>• Exhibitors must include the names of handlers and riders on their entry – failure to do so may result in the horse not being eligible for end of year awards.</li> </ul> <b>ALL OWNERS MUST HAVE A COPY OF THEIR PAPERWORK WITH THEM AT THE SHOW.</b> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• The WAAHA Inc Committee reserves the right to conditionally refuse, cancel or accept any entry.</li> </ul>
6.	<b>ORGANISING COMMITTEE</b> - Reserves the right, without assigning reason, to:- (a) reject or cancel any entry at any time; (b) cancel any event or class; (c) divide or combine classes; (d) transfer an exhibit from one class to another; (e) expel any exhibit/exhibitor from the competition and from the grounds.
7.	<b>CONDUCT</b> - Competitors shall at all times behave in a proper and respectful manner to Judges, Officials and fellow competitors. Any exhibitor whose conduct is considered to be ill-mannered, aggressive or unsportsmanlike may be issued a warning and subsequently dismissed from the class or disqualified from the Show. Please refer to the current AHSA Ltd Rule Book for information. <b>BULLYING OF ANY DESCRIPTION WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.</b>
8.	<b>EXHIBIT NUMBERS</b> - Exhibit numbers must be worn on the back of the handler/rider, around the horse's neck or on the horse's nearside in the case of costume/fancy dress classes. Competitors must not enter any class without their correct exhibit number displayed.
9.	<b>LAMENESS</b> - Horses exhibiting any sign of serious lameness in the opinion of the Judge and/or the WAAHA committee will be excused from the class and take no further part in competition for the remainder of the day. <b>THIS IS AN ANIMAL WELFARE ISSUE.</b> Whip and/or Spur abuse of any kind will not be tolerated.
10.	<b>SWABBING</b> - Any exhibit may be swabbed for prohibited substances. Results of swabs taken will be published. Horses returning a positive swab will be subject to penalties as per current AHSA Ltd Rule Book. <b>A copy of registration certificates must be available on the day.</b>
11.	<b>GROUND FEES</b> - Are compulsory for all exhibitors who are not current EWA members and MUST be paid with the entry. Proof of current EWA membership to be supplied with entry. <b>SEC Levy must be paid by all competitors.</b>

12.	<b>STABLING AND CAMPING</b> - Camping fees are compulsory for all exhibitors who are not current EWA members. <b>Stable fees are applicable to everyone.</b> Please note that all stables and camp sites are to be booked as per instructions on the SEC website <a href="http://www.secbrigadoon.com/">http://www.secbrigadoon.com/</a> . <b>DO NOT SEND THESE FORMS OR FEES TO WAAHA.</b>
13.	<b>REGISTERED PARTICIPANT FEE</b> - There will be no more Day Registered Participants at AHSA and AHSA Affiliate Events. Every participant at an Arabian event must either be an AHSA Member or an AHSA Affiliate Member. AHSA Members will be covered for Personal Accident Insurance at approved AHSA and AHSA Affiliate events as well as Public Liability Insurance. A new annual Participation Membership category within the Society's Direct Membership is now available for handlers, riders, strappers etc. to participate. This membership is for Insurance purposes only. Participant Membership will cost \$30.00 and the Participant Member will be covered for Personal Accident Insurance at approved AHSA and AHSA Affiliate events as well as Public Liability Insurance. Any AHSA membership DOES NOT qualify you for WAAHA membership rates.
14.	<b>SHOW HACK AND SHOW HUNTER CLASSES</b> - Horses may only compete in either Show Hack or Show Hunter classes, not both.
15.	<b>NON-PROFESSIONAL CLASSES</b> - Competitors in these classes must supply a declaration claiming non-professional status. A copy of the declaration must be provided with your entry. No proof = no entry.
16.	<b>DRESSAGE</b> - Where dressage classes are offered, all tests will be run in accordance with the current EA dressage rules if no show specific rules exist. Horses must not compete below their official graded level or at more than two consecutive levels. If any horse has received 70% or more at any WAAHA event prior, they may NOT compete at the level below. No horse may compete in more than two tests. <b>Only one rider per horse is permitted in dressage.</b> Draw will be emailed to competitors.
17.	<b>LEAD LINE CLASSES 74 &amp; 75</b> - Horses competing in Class 74 Open Mount suitable for Leading Rein may not compete in any other ridden class with the Lead line rider off the lead on either day. Lead line riders competing in Class 75 may not compete in any other rider class or ridden class off the lead.
18.	<b>WA BRED</b> - Where these classes are offered, the sire and dam of the exhibit must have been owned and resident in Western Australia at the time of breeding.
19.	<b>ARABIAN PERFORMANCE INDEX</b> - Arabian Performance Index recorded horses and ponies with AHSA, are eligible to compete in any class not specified for any particular Arabian Derivative registry. They are not eligible to compete in classes listed as being restricted to Purebred Arabians, Half Arabians, Partbred Arabians, Arabian Ponies, Arabian Riding Ponies, Anglo Arabians, Arabian Warmbloods, Arabian Stock Horses or Quarabs or those classes with Derivative in their title. They may be used in Junior Handler classes, Lead Line etc. <i>API are eligible for the following classes only: 39, 40, 54-56, 62- 64, 70-79, 98, 99.</i>
20.	<b>HALF ARABIAN</b> - Half Arabian classes are for those registered in the Half Arabian registry of the AHSA. Half Arabians competing in Half Arabian classes will be judged on Arabian Type as well as conformation and movement.
21.	<b>DUAL REGISTERED</b> - Horses entering Dual registered classes MUST provide proof of dual registration, and must be shown under the name of the registered AHSA owner.
22.	<b>BROOD MARE</b> - A brood mare is a mare which has a foal at foot or which is due to foal during the current breeding season (i.e. between 1st August and following 31st July) or has delivered a foal registered by the Society in the previous 2 years or holds a Pregnancy Certificate to foal in the next breeding season. Pregnancy Certificate or AHSA documentation should be available and supplied with entries if required. If exhibiting a Brood Mare with a foal at foot, said foal must be led by a competent handler, they must not be running free next to their dam. <b>RIDDEN MARES with foals at foot</b> Mares with foals at foot may be ridden in the applicable ridden mare class only. The mare WILL be excused from the class if the foal's presence or behavior interferes or distracts other mares in that class.

Each horse is scored on a score sheet; score sheets may be collected from the show office after results have been posted. Lengthening of any gait may be required; a rein back whilst lined up may also be executed. <b>Horses are presented as if for a show hunter class in with no bling browbands and minimal makeup.</b> No scoring sheet is used for saddle classes.</p>
27.	<p><b>ULTIMATE CLASSES</b></p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>• Qualification - a horse must compete and place in their breed halter and breed ridden classes to qualify to compete in the Ultimate class. A breed class is a mare, stallion or gelding class that is not restricted by handler or rider age or status.</li> <li>• Judging – The class is conducted in two parts. In Part 1 exhibits are presented to the judge(s) in halter and each exhibit is given a score out of 10 (one being the lowest score and ten being the highest). In Part 2, exhibits are presented to the judge(s) under saddle where a ridden workout is completed and each exhibit is given an additional score out of 10.</li> <li>• Scoring - The led and ridden Parts of the class are each worth 50%. The points from both parts of the class are combined and the highest score wins. Ties are split by the higher halter score.</li> <li>• Presentation of winner - Horses to be saddled at the completion of the class for presentations. Places awarded will be gold, silver and bronze for first, second and third respectively.</li> <li>• Judges – One or two judges may be used. If one judge is used (one judge for Part A and one judge for Part B) the score is out of 20, and if two are used (both judge Part A and Part B) the score is out of 40.</li> <li>• Handler/Rider – there must only be one rider and one handler per horse. These may be the same person, or two people. There should be no more than two individuals in the ring at any one time.</li> <li>• There is no restriction on the number of times an exhibit can win this class, provided that it enters and contests the class in accordance with the rules.</li> <li>• <i>Committee reserves the right to modify the way this class is judged on the day if the situation dictates – e.g. cancellation of classes due to extreme weather, etc</i></li> </ul>
28.	<p><b>FASHIONS ON THE FIELD – open to both male and female handlers. It will be scored by both judges using the following criteria:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>a.
