

Entry is open to all purebred and derivative Arabians registered with AHSA, shown under their registered AHSA name, owned by a 2018 member of ASHA, owned and shown by a 2018 member of WAAHA.

You must attend at least three 2018 WA Agricultural Shows to be eligible.

Your completed sheet must be returned to the WAAHA Treasurer: Erica Stotter, 196 Bushmead Rd, Hazelmere

by 30.11.18

All recorded points should be signed as true and correct by a show official (judge, organiser, show committee member) and must be signed by the horse's owner to be considered.

The WAAHA committee to reserve the right to amend rules and conditions if required.

All decisions are final.

Recording Points:

You can claim one set of points in all Categories at any one agricultural show – meaning you could claim points in just halter; halter and ridden breed; halter, ridden breed and hacking; hacking, ridden breed, show jumping and novelties etc.

You select your best result in each Category and record that (Champion and Reserve Champion may also be counted).

Points to be recorded:

1st = 6, 2nd = 4, 3rd = 2, 4th = 1

Champion = 4

Reserve Champion = 2
