

Entry is open to all Purebred and Derivative Arabians registered with AHSA, shown under their registered AHSA name, owned by a 2018 member of ASHA, owned and shown by a 2018 member of WAAHA.

You must attend at least three 2018 dressage events to be eligible.

Your completed sheet must be returned to the WAAHA Treasurer: Erica Stotter, 196 Bushmead Rd, Hazelmere

by 30.11.18

All recorded points must be signed as true and correct by a show official (judge, organiser, show committee member) to be considered.

The WAAHA committee to reserve the right to amend rules and conditions if required.

All decisions are final.

Recording Points:

You can claim two sets of points at any one dressage event – but they must be at different dressage levels.

Dressage tests done as part of an eventing competition are not eligible.

Points to be recorded:

1st = 6, 2nd= 4, 3rd=2, 4th = 1

Unplaced but above 60% = 1 point

Training days where placings are not given = 1 point

**NB Dressage events run by WAAHA and/or Perth H&PC earn double the points listed above.

Should there be a draw in final points, higher AHSA graded shows will take precedence.
