Rules and Conditions of Entry

It is the responsibility of the Exhibitor/Owner to abide by all rules set out here and in associated documentation.

1.	ASSOCIATION LIABILITY - The Western Australian Arabian Horse Association Inc. (WAAHA Inc.) or any of its Agents, shall not be liable for any financial loss or damage, physical injury or property damage suffered by any person by reason of any defect, accident, negligence or neglect however arising.
2.	SHOW RULES - This show is for Arabian and Arabian Derivatives and is governed by the current Arabian Horse Society of Australia Rule Book, EWA, and the SEC Rules and Regulations where no specific show rule is available. It is the responsibility of the entrant to read and be familiar with the rules and requirements for all classes. The current AHSA Rule book is available online at www.waaha.com.au or www.ahsa.asn.au . ** Competitors CANNOT be in contact with judges prior to competing.
3.	SEC RULES - Any persons entering the stable area does so at their own risk and EWA and WAAHA Inc. will not be held liable for any injury which may occur to riders, horses and general public. Under no circumstances may horses be tacked or tied up in the aisles. Smoking is only permitted on the entrance road side of the main SEC pavilion – smoking will not be tolerated or accepted in any other area. No alcohol may be brought into the Centre. PLEASE DO NOT ENTER STABLES OR MARSHALLING AREA WITH PRAMS AND/OR SMALL CHILDREN. UNACCOMPANIED CHILDREN ARE ALSO NOT PERMITTED IN THESE AREAS.
4.	MEMBERS RATES - Only current 2019 Junior, General, Family/Joint and Life members of the WAAHA Inc., whose name appears on the Registration Certificate of an exhibit as the Owner or Lessee, are eligible to enter at WAAHA member's rates. Membership fees must be paid before or on the close of entries. Non-members of WAAHA (Inc.) competing in Rider/Handler classes MUST pay non-member rates for those classes regardless of the horse owner's membership status.
5.	ENTRIES – All entries must be made in the name of the registered owner/lessee of the exhibit. Entries can be submitted online via nominat.com.au , via post or via email and must be accompanied by the correct payment and all supporting documents. Refund or credits will not be made after the closing date of entries. A payment plan may be used, but full payment must be made by close of entries. Incorrect and/or incomplete entries that have not been finalised by close of entries will incur an additional \$25/\$50 penalty fee. This may mean your entry is NOT listed in the catalogue. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • By lodging an entry the exhibitor shall be bound by the terms & conditions set out herein. The signature of an entry form by an exhibitor shall be deemed to evidence acceptance of same. • Owners of ALL Purebreds and Derivatives must be CURRENT FINANCIAL MEMBERS OF AHSA to enter their horse(s) at this show. • Horses without a registration number cannot be exhibited. • All horses must be able to be identified by their brands and/or markings in accordance with the Certificate of Registration issued by the Society. • Exhibitors must include the names of handlers and riders on their entry – failure to do so may result in the horse not being eligible for end of year awards. ALL OWNERS MUST HAVE A COPY OF THEIR PAPERWORK WITH THEM AT THE SHOW. • The WAAHA Inc. Committee reserves the right to conditionally refuse, cancel or accept any entry.
6.	GROUND FEES: Are compulsory for all exhibitors who are not current EWA members and MUST be paid with the entry. <u>Proof of current EWA/SEC membership to be supplied with entry.</u> The EWA Levy is applicable to ALL horses entered and must be paid with entry fees.
7.	REGISTERED PARTICIPANT FEE - There will be no more Day Registered Participants at AHSA and AHSA Affiliate Events. Every participant at an Arabian event must either be an AHSA Member or an AHSA Affiliate Member. AHSA Members will be covered for Personal Accident Insurance at approved AHSA and AHSA Affiliate events as well as Public Liability Insurance. A new annual Participation Membership category within the Society's Direct Membership is now available for handlers, riders, strappers etc. to participate. This membership is for Insurance purposes only. Participant Membership will cost \$30.00 and the Participant Member will be covered for Personal Accident Insurance at approved AHSA and AHSA Affiliate events as well as Public Liability Insurance. Any AHSA membership DOES NOT qualify you for WAAHA membership rates.
8.	SHOW COMMITTEE shall have the power, without assigning any reason to: a) Reject or cancel any entry at any time. b) Prohibit the participation by any person or exhibit in any event or class for which it is entered. c) Cancel, combine or divide any event or class. d) Alter the time at which any class or event is to take place. e) Order the removal of any exhibit from the Show grounds. f) Transfer an exhibit from any class to any other class. g) Act upon any report of cruelty to any exhibit on the Showground. Clauses b) and e) above may be invoked. h) Enforce the exclusion of any exhibit which has been excused from any class upon the direction of a Judge AHSA RULE 5.5 18/5/18
9.	CONDUCT - Competitors shall at all times behave in a proper and respectful manner to Judges, Officials and fellow competitors. Any exhibitor whose conduct is considered to be ill-mannered, aggressive or unsportsmanlike may be issued a warning and subsequently dismissed from the class or disqualified from the Show. Please refer to the current AHSA Ltd Rule Book for information. BULLYING OF ANY DESCRIPTION WILL NOT BE TOLERATED.
10.	EXHIBIT NUMBERS: Exhibit numbers must be worn on the back of the handler/rider, around the horses' neck or somewhere visible in costume classes. Competitors must not enter any class without their correct exhibit number displayed
11.	STIRRING Shakers or any other artificial device must only be used in moderation by the Marshall/Steward/Show Official and only upon request from the competitor at the time of entry to the judging ring. Refer to AHSA rulebook for more information. Clapping and cheering of horses is encouraged however banging or stomping on seating/railing/bins is prohibited.
12.	LAMENESS: Horses exhibiting any sign of serious lameness in the opinion of the Judge and/or organising committee will be excused from the class and take no further part in competition for the remainder of the day. THIS IS AN ANIMAL WELFARE ISSUE. Exhibits displaying whip or spur marks will also not be judged
13.	SWABBING - Any exhibit may be swabbed for prohibited substances. Results of swabs taken will be published. Horses returning a positive swab will be subject to penalties as per current AHSA Ltd Rule Book. A copy of registration certificates must be available on the day.
14.	STABLING AND CAMPING - Camping fees are compulsory for all exhibitors who are not current EWA members. Stable fees are applicable to everyone. Please note that all stables and camp sites are to be booked as per instructions on the SEC website http://www.wa.equestrian.org.au/sec/make-booking DO NOT SEND THESE FORMS OR FEES TO WAAHA.

15.	NON-PROFESSIONAL CLASSES - Open to competitors 18 years & over. Competitors in these classes must supply a SIGNED declaration claiming non-professional status. A declaration must be provided with your entry. No proof = no entry.
16.	HALF ARABIAN CLASSES: are for those registered in the Half Arabian registry of the AHSA. Half Arabians competing in Half Arabian classes will be judged on Arabian Type as well as conformation and movement.
17.	ARABIAN PERFORMANCE INDEX: Arabian Performance Index recorded horses and ponies with AHSA, are eligible to compete in any class not specified for any particular Arabian Derivative registry. They are not eligible to compete in classes listed as being restricted to Purebred Arabians, Half Arabians, Partbred Arabians, Arabian Ponies, Arabian Riding Ponies, Anglo Arabians, Arabian Warmbloods, Arabian Stock Horses or Quarabs or those classes with Derivative in their title. They may be used in Junior Handler classes, Lead Line etc. <i>API are eligible for the following classes only 24,39-42,55-56,67,69-71,73,75,78-80,82-83,94-96,98-102,104-105,107,109,111,114,117</i>
18.	LEADLINE CLASSES – Youth riding in Leadline rider class CANNOT also compete in open youth rider class 82.
19.	DRESSAGE Where dressage classes are offered, all tests will be run in accordance with the current EA dressage rules, unless there is a specific show or AHSA rule. Horses must not compete below or above their official graded level or at more than two consecutive levels. Only one rider per horse is permitted in dressage. No horse may compete in more than two tests. Draw will be posted on the WAAHA website (events page) prior to the show.
20.	HIGH PERCENTAGE ARABIAN DERIVATIVES must be more than 50% to compete in this class.
21.	DUAL REGISTERED – Open to all Purebred Arabian/Arabian Derivatives/API that are registered with another breed society. Proof of registration must be provided with your entries. Dilute/Broken coloured horses may only compete once in classes 69 – 71.
22.	AWARDS: All classes will receive Champion, Reserve and all remaining horses Finalist (unless otherwise stated)
23.	** FEATURE CLASS - SHOW HORSE The ridden Showhorse class is judged 1/3 on presentation, 1/3 on conformation and 1/3 on manners & paces. Judged on the ring. It will be judged by all judges numerically to achieve results. In the event of a tie, the highest score for presentation shall take precedence.
24.	SPORTHORSE CLASSES: Sport horse in hand is judging form to function conformation, without any apparent artifice. The horses are bought into the ring individually, and judged on their conformation and movement as it pertains to their ability to make a good performance horse. Each horse is scored on a score sheet; score sheets may be collected from the show office after results have been posted. There is a set workout, which will be emailed to competitors after close of entries. Horses are to be shown in a plain bridle, leather stable halter or plain show halter. Make up is minimal. Upon being directed by the steward to enter the ring, each horse will walk straight towards the judge, halt and be stood in a more natural pose (lowered head and neck) than used in other Arabian in hand classes. An 'open stance' (i.e. all 4 legs visible from either side) may also be used. The judge will then direct the competitor to complete the set workout, walk a triangle, then trot a triangle, before halting again. The horse then leaves the ring via the exit. The workout and blank scoring sheet will be emailed to competitors after close of entries. Sport horse saddle classes are judged on the circle at the walk, trot and canter. Lengthening of any gait may be required; a rein back whilst lined up may also be executed. Horses are presented as if for a show hunter class with no bling browbands and minimal makeup. No scoring sheet is used for saddle classes. ** It is the competitor's responsibility to know the rules and requirements for these classes.
25.	** FEATURE CLASS - WAAHA FREESTYLE CUP: is a saddle class open to all horses 4 years and over. Competitors will ride a minimum of 2 minutes, to maximum of 3 minute workout of their own choice, to music of their own choice, containing the following compulsory movements; a) Walk, b) Trot, c) Canter on left rein and right rein, d) Halt in front of Judges. Any other movements are optional. This is NOT a traditional hack class and will not be judged as such. Competitors may dress in English, Side saddle, Western, Stockhorse gear, or Fancy dress. *All gear must be safely and correctly fitted. No gear that ties / secures rider to horse will be permitted. * Bare feet in stirrups will not be permitted. *Any rider under the age of 18 must wear an approved safety helmet. *No electrical apparatus, martingales, draw reins, tie downs, chains across horse's nose or poll permitted. *Horses to be ridden in either an English snaffle bit, Pelham bit with chain and lip strap, simple double bridle with lip strap, or acceptable western bits; cowboy snaffle, grazing snaffle, jointed snaffle with shanks, half breed, bar and spade. Competitors will be scored numerically out of 10, by all Judges, in the following criteria; 1. Quality of free walk on long rein 2. Quality of trot 3. Quality of canter left 4. Quality of canter right 5. Quality of halt 6. Composition and flow of workout (any other movements included) 7. Harmony of combination (Submission/obedience) 8. Suitability of dress to music 9. Suitability of workout to music 10. Overall impression In the event of a tie, highest combined scores in section 10 shall take precedence. If a tie still exists, the highest combined scores in section 6 shall take precedence.
26.	** FEATURE CLASS - PUREBRED ARABIAN RISING STAR: Open to all junior Purebred Arabians 3 years & under. This is a sponsored class with \$500 prize money to be divided \$400 for Champion and \$100 for Reserve. Entry Fees less cost of sashes to be added to the prize pool. Class entry fee is \$30 for all entrants.

**Arena familiarisation will be available from 7.30 – 8.30am on Saturday and 6.45-7.30am on Sunday.

NON-PRO DECLARATION

(Effective 1st August 2014)

Definition of a Non-Pro

A non-pro is one who, regardless of his/her equestrian skills and/or accomplishments, in the past three years has not directly or indirectly accepted as payment, goods or money for services usually provided by a professional in the areas of breaking, riding, training, schooling, driving, halter preparation, showing in halter or under saddle.

The following activities shall not affect the Non-Pro status of a person who is otherwise qualified;

- a) The writing of books
- b) Accepting remuneration for judging or stewarding
- c) Speaking at workshops, clinics, seminars or training days in a voluntary capacity where they do not accept a fee for their services.
- d) Receiving prize money or goods as services.
- e) Having the occupation of farrier, veterinarian, stable hand or groom.
- f) Owning or operating a saddlery, stud or breeding farm or boarding stables.

Spouses and immediate family of a trainer are also able to be registered as a Non-Pro, providing they are not involved with any of the above listed activities with horses where the trainer is being paid.
