Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. The Committee of the West Australian Arabian Horse Association Inc. (WAAHA) reserve the right to cancel, alter or combine any event(s) they deem necessary on the day.
2. All competitors must be a member of AHSA or WAAHA for insurance purposes to compete or ride on the grounds. Day membership is available for any competitor who is not a member. Non-Members MUST complete the Day Membership and AHSA Liability Form and send back with their entries.
3. This event is open to unofficial horses and riders only. Horse/rider combinations who have competed officially in the past 12 months cannot enter the unofficial/encouragement classes.
4. Height certificates are not compulsory however horses are to compete in the correct height class.
5. All horses/ponies are to wear snaffle bridles – no double bridles will be permitted. Plaiting and Jackets are optional. No martingales allowed. Lead rein – leads must be attached to the back of the noseband. Lead Rein competitors may not compete off lead in any event.
6. Riders competing in Arabian or Arabian Derivative classes must show a copy of the horses AHSA registration certificate when nominating and must be entered in the registered owner's name and the registered owner must be a current member of:
 - a. AHSA if the horse is an Arabian mare or stallion, or Arabian Derivate stallion
 - b. WAAHA if the horse is an Arabian gelding, or Arabian Derivative mare or gelding or API any sex.
7. The grounds are public open space and cannot be sealed from public access.
8. All persons on horseback are required to wear an approved helmet meeting current safety standards and boots as a condition of entry.
9. Dressage will be run under current EA Rules. Horses may not compete below their graded level, can compete in two consecutive levels and a maximum of 3 tests.
10. All ponies can be ridden by any age rider unless stated otherwise.
11. Tractable stallions may be ridden by a rider 18 years and over. Stallions must wear green discs and comply with EA Stallion Safe Rules. Unruly or dangerous horses will be asked to leave the grounds.
12. The judge's decision is final. Protests must be received in writing within 30 minutes of the conclusion of the event in question, with a \$100 fee attached. Refund will only occur if the protest is upheld.
13. WAAHA reserves the right to interpret the rules and make a decision where any dispute arises. Under no circumstances is approaching the judge, judging or coaching from the side of the ring permitted. Failure to abide by these rules will lead to immediate disqualification and forfeit of entry fees.
14. Dogs on the grounds must be kept securely on the leash at all times.
15. **No hay is permitted outside of horse floats or trucks – COUNCIL REGULATION**
16. Riding on the grounds is not permitted if you are not entered, unless you pay an insurance levy, ground fee and sign a disclaimer.
17. Please take all rubbish home with you and leave the grounds neat and tidy at the end of the day.
18. The organising Committee of WAAHA, judges, officials, do not accept liability for any accident, loss, damage, illness or injury to horses, owners, riders, spectators or any other person or property whatsoever. Entry to the grounds is at your own risk and the 'Waiver of Liability' form must be signed by all entrants prior to participation; this is a condition of our insurance.
19. Entries are pre-entry only – NO ENTRIES on the day. 50% refund will be offered if a vet/doctors certificate is presented on or prior to the commencement of the event.
20. In the event of Government restrictions preventing this event from running, a full refund of entries will be given.

In consideration for being permitted to participate in any way in horse sport activities and in particular this event, I, the undersigned, understand, acknowledge and accept that:

Horse sports are a dangerous recreational activity and horses can act in a sudden and unpredictable (changeable) way, especially if frightened or hurt.

There is a significant risk that serious INJURY or DEATH may result from horse sport activities and in particular this event.

I knowingly and freely assume all such risks, both known and unknown, even if arising from the negligence of the proprietors of the AHSA or AHSA Affiliate and / or the event organiser (hereafter referred to as the "Releasees") or others and I voluntarily PARTICIPATE at my OWN RISK and assume sole responsibility for any injury, death or property damage I may suffer that arises from my participation in horse sport activities.



I understand and acknowledge the dangers associated with the consumption of alcohol or any mind altering drugs before and during the activity and I take full responsibility for any injury, loss or damage associated with their consumption. I agree to wear a helmet at all times whilst riding and agree that I am solely responsible for ensuring that I wear a suitable helmet at all times while riding and take sole responsibility for my actions.

I, for myself and on behalf of my heirs, assigns, personal representatives and next of kin, hereby release and hold harmless and agree not to sue the proprietors of the AHSA or AHSA Affiliate and / or the event organiser, their officers, officials, volunteers, coaches, agents and/or employees, other participants, sponsoring agencies, sponsors, state bodies, affiliated clubs and if applicable, owners and lessors of premises used to conduct the activities (all of whom are referred to as "Releasees") with respect to any and all injury, disability, death, or loss or damage to person or property, whether caused by the negligence of the releasees or otherwise.
